

The MAO-XXX Series of reports are received from CMS for several purposes. Using them together enhances ED submissions and data reconciliations. Also, knowing the differences helps plans to use the reports appropriately for its intended purpose.

MAO-001 – Encounter Data Duplicates Report	Identifies duplicate errors in ED submissions	The identification of duplicates by the MAO-001 report highlights the need for improved ED management and submission practices.	Directly to CMS via MAPD Helpdesk	Within 5 days.
MAO-002 – Encounter Data Processing Status Report	Provides information on the disposition status (either accepted or rejected) and error codes for all records and lines processed by EDPS. Also Prelim RA flags.	Understanding the root causes of all submission errors is crucial for preventing future errors and enhancing the overall quality of ED submissions.	Secure File Transfer Protocol (SFTP) Connect:Direct	
MAO-004 – Encounter Data Diagnosis Eligible for Risk Adjustment	Informs MAOs and other entities about the risk adjustment eligibility of diagnosis data on submitted and accepted Encounter Data Records (EDRs) and Chart Review Records (CRRs).	Identify the risk adjustment eligibility of diagnoses. This information can be used to determine which diagnoses make it to the model input file for the risk adjustment model runs.	Gentran Mailbox/TIBCO MFT Internet Server Connect:Direct MARx UI	Monthly basis from data submitted in the immediately preceding month.
